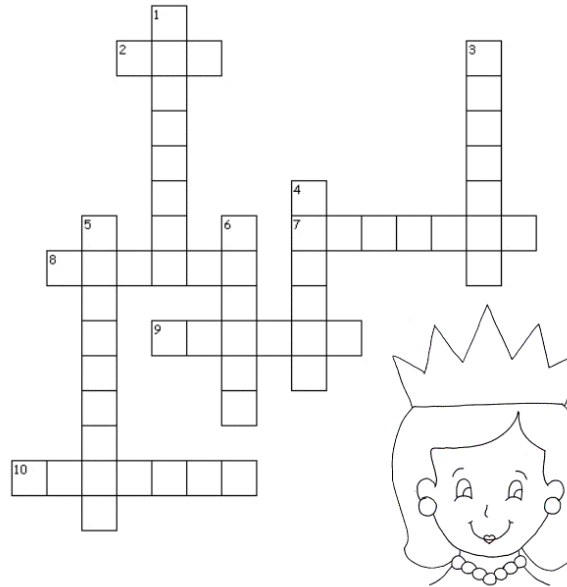

Esther Crossword

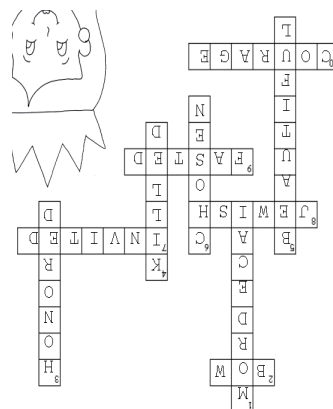

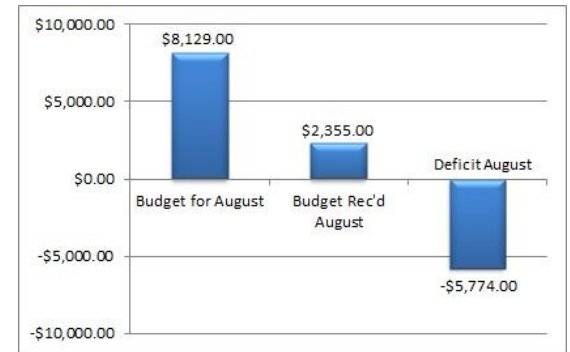

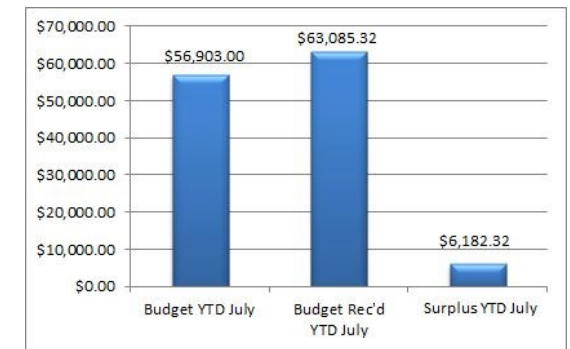
