



Elijah Prays Maze



Sermon Corner

Scripture: 1 Kings 18:41-44

Elijah stood amidst a nation in spiritual rebellion and a land scorched by drought, declaring, "There is the sound of abundance of rain" (1 Kings 18:41, NKJV). For three and a half years, the heavens had been silent, the earth parched, and hope all but lost. Yet Elijah climbed Mount Carmel and bowed in prayer—not once, but seven times—persisting until every shred of self was surrendered and Christ's glory filled his heart.

This is the key to revival: humble, faith-filled, and unrelenting prayer. It was only after Elijah became nothing and Christ became everything that the rain came, breaking the drought and restoring the land.
